Fees

On-campus: EUR 350 per course*

Online: EUR 250 per course

* Partner institutions: The tuition fee will be waived for students from partner universities, exemption from tuition fees may be granted.

Housing

Housing is not included in the summer program package, but MCI will assist participants to find housing in Innsbruck for the duration of the program, usually in a student dorm.

Estimated cost EUR 500.

Visa

Students from certain countries require a visa for entering Austria. MCI will provide students with information on visa requirements.

Innsbruck offers exciting sports and leisure opportunities such as hiking, swimming, zip-lining or simply going for a relaxed stroll along the river Inn. - Vienna, Austria's gorgeous capital city with its rich imperial past
- Venice, one of the world's most romantic cities
